

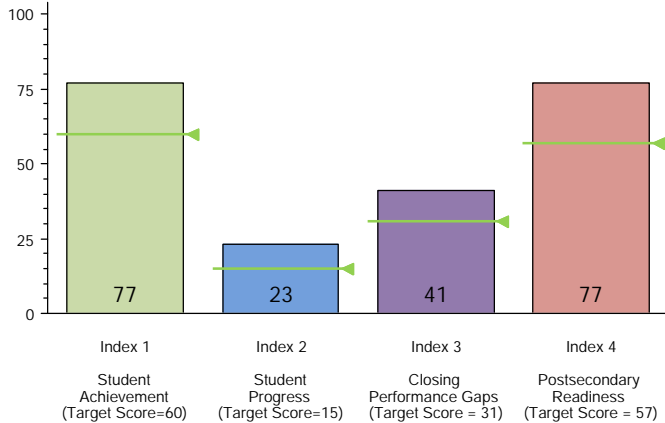

2015 Performance Index

State accountability ratings are based on four performance indexes: Student Achievement, Student Progress, Closing Performance Gaps, and Postsecondary Readiness. In 2015, to receive the Met Standard or Met Alternative Standard accountability rating, districts and campuses must meet targets on three indexes: Index 1 or Index 2 and Index 3 and Index 4.
